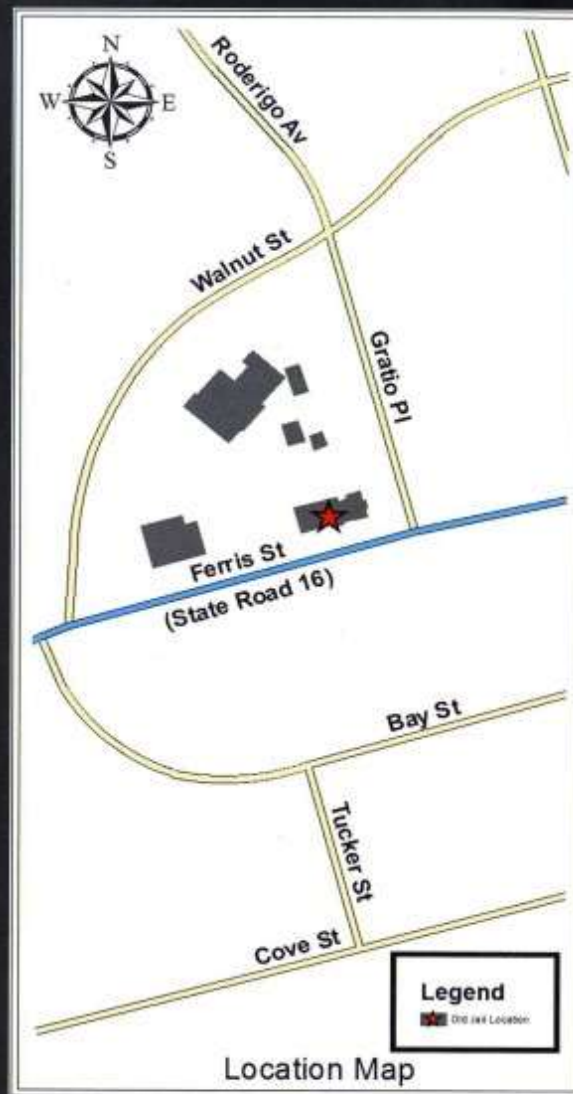


The Old 1894 Jail is open for paranormal investigation. Teams can call and reserve their night. Teams will receive exclusive use of the Old Jail for one night and a brief historical tour of the jail.

Fees start at \$10 per person, with a minimum of 3 persons per team please. Reservation required. All minors must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

Contact the Clay County Archives at 904-284-2386 or 904-371-0027 to reserve a night. During the hours of 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and except for county holidays, the Old Jail is usually open to the public for self-guided tours.

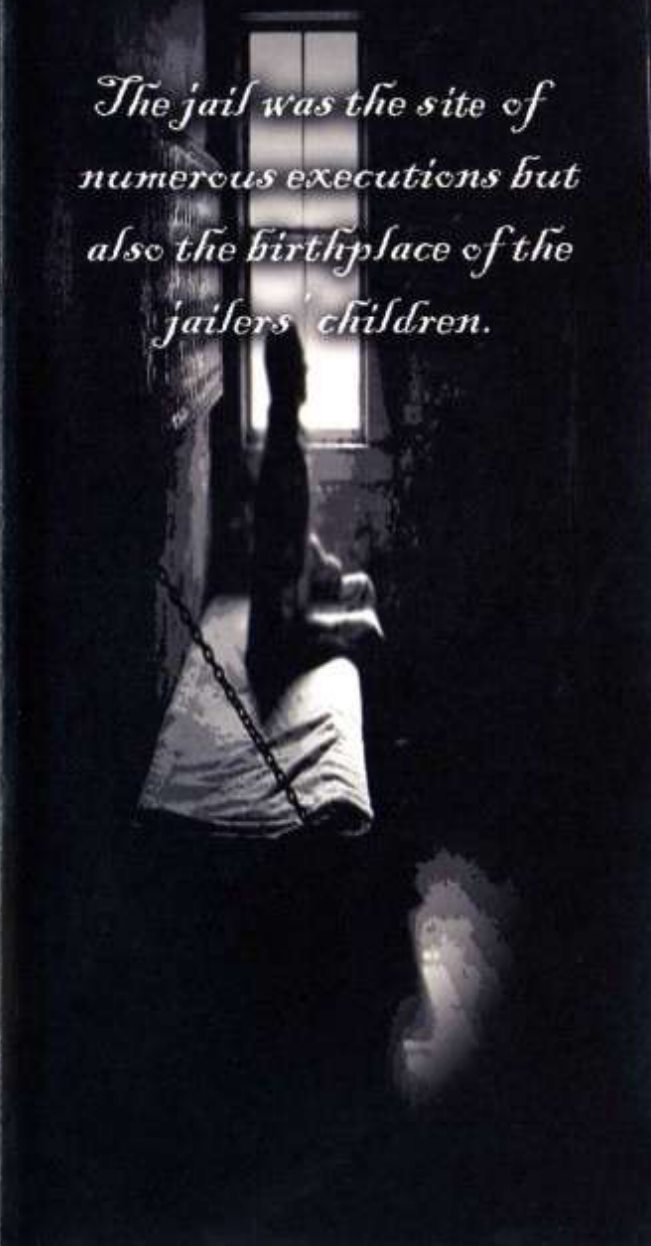

Open from 1894 to 1972 the jail has a long history of both life and death.
